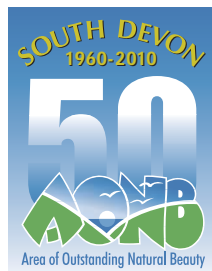

Celebrating 50 years as a protected landscape!



There are three themed categories in which to enter:

Classic landscape – an image that captures the beauty and variety of the South Devon AONB, and its relevance to you.

Settlements and villages (built environment) – Buildings play a big role in most landscapes and South Devon is no different. What do you consider characteristic or distinguishable about buildings in the South Devon AONB?

Living the view – There are a wide range of lifestyles in the AONB. Images may portray a lifestyle whether work, or school, traditional or modern showing people working or playing in the AONB landscape and the importance of the AONB community.

2010 is the year South Devon celebrates 50 years as an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. Designated by government in 1960 it is recognised as one of England's finest landscapes.

Please help us mark the occasion by entering our photography competition, showing why you think this area is so special.

Try to delve beneath the surface to capture elements of our landscape or lives that will help us see and promote the AONB in a fresh way.

Take your camera wherever you go and capture your everyday life in a way which will inspire others and illustrate a story to express what the image means to you and your life.

The panel of three judges will be chaired by Roy Sims past Vice Principal of Plymouth College of Art and Design.

Each category will have an under 16 section

All photos to be captioned by the photographer letting us know where and why you took them. Entries are limited to four per person.

Photos should have been taken since January 2007.

All entries will be featured on the website. Following short listing the finalists will appear in a new gallery, and the local press. The public will vote for their favourite image in each category at: www.sdaonb-comp.org.uk. A selection of the entries will be used to form an exhibition at Harbour House in Kingsbridge as part of the 50th anniversary celebrations from 6th – 18th July 2010.

The closing date for entries is 30th April 2010





All images must be taken within the AONB designated area – the green area on this map depicts the South Devon AONB



Prizes

The overall winner will receive a pair of balloon ride tickets sponsored by Virgin Balloon Flights, and a framed 20 x 16 art print of their image from King Print.

The best Under 16 entry will receive a Kodak EASYSHARE digital camera sponsored by Totnes Photographic.

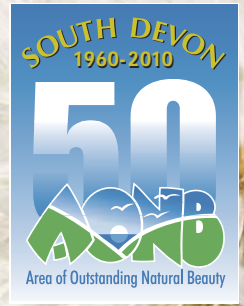
Each of the section winners, will also receive a fine art print of their image sponsored by King Print in Kingsbridge (12 x 16).

The prize winners and all finalists will be exhibited as part of a 50th anniversary exhibition at Harbour House Kingsbridge from 6th July – 18th July 2010.



Terms and Conditions

1. The organiser is The South Devon Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty.
2. All photographs must be taken in the South Devon Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty.
3. Each entrant must be the originator and owner of the copyright for all images entered.
4. The competition is open to all amateur photographers (excluding the AONB service) and is split into 2 age groups - young people under 16 and adults.
5. Entries may be colour or black and white.
6. A maximum of 4 entries per competitor is permitted.
7. Entries must be provided in a digital format either on disc or via the website at www.sdevonaonb.org.uk (minimum resolution 1600 x 1200 / approx 2 megapixels). Please provide a stamped addressed envelope if it is to be returned.
8. Photographs should have been taken since 1st January 2007.
9. The closing date is 30th April 2010.
10. All entries sent by post must be accompanied by a completed application form, captions for each image, a signed terms and condition form and received by the South Devon AONB office, Follaton House, Plymouth Road, Totnes, and TQ9 5NE. Applications can also be made via the website.
11. Entries may not be withdrawn once received.
12. Entrants retain copyright of images but South Devon AONB reserves the right to use the image in publicity material for the organisation. Images will not be used for commercial gain.
13. The panel of 3 professionally qualified judges will draw up the shortlist of entries.
14. All entries will be posted on the website and following short listing the public will be invited to vote for their favourites on-line.
15. Winning and short listed entries will be exhibited at Harbour House Gallery Kingsbridge from July 6th – 18th 2010.
16. The organiser's decision is final. The AONB reserves the right to change any aspect of the competition.
17. All reasonable care will be taken of entries, but the South Devon AONB cannot be held responsible for damage or loss.
